**Tenebrae Service - Maunday Thursday - 8-9pm** - This is a special service for Holy week. The word Tenebrae is Latin for shadows and the purpose of the service is to re-create through the use of increasing darkness the betrayal, abandonment, and agony of Jesus' last hours on earth. The idea being that through entering into Christ's suffering we can then more fully appreciate the joy & wonder of Easter Day. People who have experienced a Tenebrae service say that it is one of the most moving and powerful services of the whole year.

The service will include communion, hymns, music, images and scripture readings. The evening will start with the church in candlelight then after each reading candles will be extinguished until only the candle representing Christ remains. The service therefore ends in near darkness and total silence and is left this way because the story is not over until Easter Day culminating in the celebration of the resurrection of Jesus the light of the world.
