**Bomb Blasts in Uganda** - Two simultaneous bomb blasts have ripped through crowds watching the World Cup final in Uganda's capital, killing 64 people and injuring dozens more. The explosions hit an Ethiopian restaurant in Kabalagala, a crowded suburb in the south of Kampala where there are several pubs popular with soccer fans, and a rugby sports club in the eastern part of the city. This was reported on Sunday, since then the death toll has reached 75.

This is a restaurant known to me, it is very near our school in Kabalagala. I have sat there with Jane and some of her Eritrean friends and enjoyed the ambience. It is the place where our project manager would often take her English visitors. Last weekend, Lesley had a visitor from England, but they went away for the weekend. None of our staff or children and their families have been hurt, and we thank God for that, but are saddened by these events. **Please pray for the people of Kabalagala, and especially Paddy as he ministers to people.** I have since heard from Paddy that a pastor friend and a pastor's son were killed in the attack. *Mary Dicker*
