Prison Alpha at Lewes - We are in the middle of our second Alpha this year at Lewes men's prison, with a 3rd proposed for the autumn. Although it is called Alpha, it looks very different, we do not use Nicky Gumbel's DVD's, but we do take the main elements from the Alpha course & present them in a way that speaks to the men in a language they understand, & that helps them to know God for themselves. We use many film clips, & testimonies, plus song's. We have a very varied team, including a man from Gideon's bibles, a publican, Salvation Army & several evangelists. Courses run for 6, 2 hour sessions, in the after-noon, very often we get requested to extend, normally for another 6. We have seen many come to know Jesus as their Lord & Saviour, we have baptized many & quite a lot, who were Christians before there wrong doing, re-dedicate their lives to Jesus. We have an email pray chain, that pray for the prisoners, & we receive pray requests from Lewes right throughout the year, if you want to be added, let me know. **With all God's blessings, John Goodway.**
